Team	Age	Description	Concessions
Village Hosts	21+	<p>Delegates will be pitched in villages of around 20-50 people and a couple of Hosts are responsible for each area. These people must have some experience with youth.</p> <p>Village Hosts provide a vital link between the youth and the Imagine team; getting along side the delegates, encouraging shared activities and fielding delegates' problems etc. Applicants must attend the prayer team training on site and daily Village Host meetings.</p>	Free Place
Detached Team	18+	<p>Working as a team, those accepted will be particularly involved in finding and befriending those on the fringes of the event and drawing them in, prepared to explain the Gospel where necessary. This team needs to be made up of people who are conscientious and accountable. Team applicants must attend the prayer team training on site.</p>	Free Place Free Meals
Control Team	18+	<p>Control is the face of the Imagine conferences. It is the hub for site services such as Stewarding and maintenance, as well as for delegate information and emergencies. Dealing with issues from lost children to blocked toilets, Control plays a vital role in the safe and efficient running of the event.</p>	Free Place Free Meals
First Aid	18+	<p>The team is made up of those with current medical qualifications. Doctors, Nurses and first-aiders are required to join the team on a shift basis.</p>	Free Place Free Meals
Sports	16 +	<p>Sports team provides a programme of activities each afternoon, catering for all ages and abilities. Experience in sports and coaching preferred but not essential.</p>	Free Place Free Meals
Stewards	16+	<p>The team provides security throughout the event, working on a shift rota, as well as helping set-up/take-down before and after the event. Physical fitness is essential. Duties include security, preparing meeting venues, ushering etc.</p>	Free Place Free Meals
Skate Park	16+	<p>The team is responsible for befriending, sharing the gospel and encouraging the young people within the venue. You will be expected to pray in the main meetings whenever possible and attend the prayer team training on site.</p>	Free Place Free Meals

All team members are required to read a copy of the Imagine Team Principles and to read, agree and sign a Child Protection Declaration form adhering to our Child Safety policies.
