TEAM	DESCRIPTION	AGE	CONCESSIONS
Control Team	Control are the silent wheels behind the Imagine conferences. They are the hub for site services such as stewarding, maintenance, delegate information and emergencies. They deal with issues from lost property to blocked toilets. Control plays a vital role in the safe and efficient running of the event.	18+	Free Place Free Meals
Detached Team	Working as a team, those accepted will be particularly involved in finding and befriending those on the fringes of the event and drawing them in, being prepared to explain the Gospel where necessary. This team needs to be made up of people who are conscientious and accountable. Team applicants must attend the Prayer Team training on site.	18+	Free Place Free Meals
First Aid Team	The team is made up of those with current medical qualifications – a mixture of Doctors, Nurses and First-Aiders are required to join the team on a shift basis.	18+	Free Place Free Meals

Skate Team	The team is responsible for befriending, sharing the gospel and encouraging the young people within the venue. Experience preferred but not essential. Sports Team	Sports team provides a programme of activities each afternoon, catering for all ages and abilities. Experience in sports and coaching preferred but not essential. Stewarding Team	The team provides security throughout the event, working on a shift rota, as well as helping set-up/take-down before and after the event. Physical fitness is essential. Duties include security, preparing meeting venues, ushering etc.	16+	Free Place Free Meals
Technical Team	Working alongside our professional sound company, you will be involved in filming and/or mixing video footage in main meetings as well helping with the day-to-day set up of seminar venues. Experience with basic PA, video, and projection is essential.	18+	Free Place Free Meals
Village Hosts	Delegates will be pitched in villages of around 50-100 people and a couple of Hosts are responsible for each area. These people must have some experience with youth. Village Hosts provide a vital link between the youth and the Imagine team; getting alongside delegates, encouraging shared activities and fielding delegates' problems etc. Applicants must attend the prayer team training on site and daily Village Host meetings.	21+	Free Place
